1. Introduction

Masorti Judaism is committed to protecting your personal information and respecting your privacy. This policy explains how we collect, use, and store your data in line with the UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018. Masorti Judaism strives to use data fairly, lawfully and transparently:

- for specified, explicit purposes
- in a way that is adequate, relevant and limited to only what is necessary
- accurately and, where necessary, kept up to date
- to be kept for no longer than is necessary, and
- handled in a way that ensures appropriate security, including protection against unlawful or unauthorised processing, access, loss, destruction or damage

2. Who We Are

We are Masorti Judaism a registered charity in England and Wales (Charity Number: 1117590) Our registered address is Alexander House, 3 Shakespeare Road, London N3 1XE

3. What Information We Collect

We may collect:

- Personal details (name, address, email, phone number)
- Donation information (amount, date, payment method)
- Volunteer and membership details
- Communication preferences
- Event participation records

4. How We Use Your Information

We use your data to:

- Process donations and claim Gift Aid
- Keep you informed about our work, events, and campaigns
- Manage volunteer applications and activities
- Comply with legal and regulatory obligations

5. Legal Basis for Processing

We process your data based on:

- Your consent
- Our legitimate interests in running the charity
- Legal obligations (e.g., HMRC requirements for Gift Aid)

6. Sharing Your Information

We will never sell your data. We may share it with trusted service providers (e.g., payment processors, email platforms) who work on our behalf, under strict confidentiality agreements.

7. Data Retention

We keep your personal data only as long as necessary for the purposes we collected it, or as required by law.

8. Your Rights

Under the legislation, you have rights in relation to your personal data, with some exceptions. These include the right to:

- be informed about how your data is being used
- access personal data
- have incorrect data updated
- have data erased
- stop or restrict the processing of your data
- data portability (allowing you to get and reuse your data for different services)
- object to how your data is processed in certain circumstances

You also have rights when an organisation is using your personal data for:

- automated decision-making processes (without human involvement)
- profiling, for example to predict your behaviour or interests

If you are concerned about how your data is being used, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO)
