Our purpose is to develop flourishing Masorti communities, rooted in traditional practice and modern values—so that people can find meaning through connecting to Judaism and to each other. With a dynamic strategy to grow existing communities, support young people, nurture Jewish innovation, and promote our ideas, this is an exciting time to join our Board of Trustees for a three year term.
